At a meeting recently with local councillors down here in Thirroul, the announcement was made that the northern beaches area here will be getting a "noise camera" test, to satisfy some local residents' complaints about motor cycle noise (Harleys) and "hooted-up" cars (mostly hoons in small hot hatches with aftermarket turbo mods doing donuts late at night). Trucks will also be targeted. The complaints come mostly from the Austinmer area with hilly bits on the Drive. Apparently the "Bayside" area of Sydney is also getting tested.



A noise camera test was run a while ago on Mt Ousley, I think for about a month, with NO criminal vehicles being caught.

Anyhow, they are at it again, quoting the relevant legislation as:

"Protection of the Environment Operations (Noise Control) Regulation 2000"

Interestingly, the following is the NSW Govt announcement:

- 1) The NSW Government has committed to trial noise camera detection system in the Bayside and Wollongong local government areas (LGAs).
- (2) The trial will evaluate if noise camera technology is fit-for-purpose to identify noisy vehicles for enforcement purposes.
- (3) The NSW Environment Protection Authority (EPA) has contacted suppliers of noise camera technology used overseas to seek information on the equipment that is currently available.
- (4) The EPA participates in joint compliance operations organised by NSW Police and Transport for NSW in areas identified as having noisy vehicles with a significant impact on the community. The maximum noise level of a motor bus, motor car, motor cycle or motor lorry is to be determined in accordance with the National <u>Stationary</u> Exhaust Noise Test Procedures.

The legislation quoted above has details of these specific "test procedures". The operative word is "STATIONARY" and refers to the vehicle status not the testing apparatus, which has extensive cautions on equipment and calibration. This legislation has been used for the stopped vehicle test we used to see at Road Warrior and other places, carried out by the constabulary, but that responsibility was shifted to the EPA a while ago.

Max levels for motor vehicles are: 90/96 (post/pre 83) dB cars, 94/100 (post/pre 3/84) dB motorcycles.

I fail to see how you could be pinged and fined for noise when the test is measuring your vehicle as you go past a stationary camera 10m away on the side of the road at 60kph on a windy day. One can only assume that they will bring in properly related legislation before handing any fines out.


